Choose your own pathways to complete the remaining requirements, complete them and receive your OSSD!




Guidance and Support to ensure success!

OES students receive guidance and support from the point of enrollment, throughout their classes and until graduation.

This support includes:

- Ontario certified teachers
- 24/7 Tutoring access
- Guidance/ Academic Advising team





Teachers

Students have access to qualified Ontario Certified Teachers who lead each course.



24/7 Tutors

Courses include access to 24/7 unlimited, on-demand, online tutoring included in the course fee. One-on-one live help for any subject, anytime and anywhere.



Guidance Team

Students have Academic Advisors to support their journey and ensure all OSSD/ future program admissions requirements are met. Guidance is also provided for social-emotional support, study skills, etc.



OES works with certified teachers and consultants from Quebec to support home schoolers meet provincial (Quebec specific) requirements.
